Public Rally & Meeting by the Tamils of U.K. against the Human Rights Violations in the Tamil Homeland

Further to our communication dated 10th July, 1989 and the subsequent meeting we had with the representatives of the various Tamil organisations on Friday the 14th July, 1989 on the above subject. We wish to bring to your notice the following and also seek your co-operation and assistance for the rally.

- 2. The Police Authority has granted permission for the rally and the meeting to be held on 29th July, 1989. The venue, route and time are stated in the notice copies of which are enclosed. Permission has also been granted for handing over petitions at 10 Downing Street and at the Indian High Commission by 6 persons in each case around 1.30 p.m. .
- 3. All out effort has to be made by all the organisations and individuals to get the largest turn-out for the rally to make it a success. It was decided to request the organisations to arrange transport where necessary. Some of the representatives who were present at the meeting have already agreed to provide transport.
- 4. Banners for the procession have to be made in English highlighting the human rights violations. The Co-ordinator of this office could be contacted for any assistance.
- 5. A concise facts sheet describing the happenings in the Tamil Homeland will also be distributed to the participants and to the others along the procession route.
- 6. Copies of the Petitions together with the Signature Sheets are enclosed. Please endeavour to collect as many signatures as possible not only from the fellow Tamils but also from the other sympathisers/ human rightists. If additional signature sheets are needed please use photo copies.
- 7. Please consider the plight of our fellow Tamils in our Homeland and extend your whole hearted co-operation and assistance by turning out in large numbers for the rally and meeting thereby making it a big success.
