8.0 HEALTH

Point Pedro Base Hospital and Valvettithurai Hospital could not cater for the Tsunami victims on 26th December, 2004. Hence there is a public agitation to upgrade the base hospital to general hospital and VVT district hospital to be provided with necessary staff.

14 Primary Health Centres have to be provided for the area. ICRC has provided four centres.

The SLRCS, Humedica Local team, and Medico do Mondose (Portuguese) team are involved in the mobile medical clinics to the coastal area.

9.0 INFRASTRUCTURE

9.1 Roads

i) Road Development Authority – Class A & B roads

About 65 km lengths of roads were damaged by Tsunami. Rs. 4000 million is required for the reconstruction of 140km roads, bridges and causeways.

ii) Road Development Department – Class C & D roads

About 29 km of roads need Rs. 96.0 million for rehabilitation.

iii) Local Authorities

About 46 km roads need Rs. 172 million for immediate rehabilitation.

9.2 Electricity

About 510 consumers were affected and the supply of electricity has been provided to the houses which are ready.

Long term rehabilitation needs

Construction of 28km 33KW line, 10 Nos substations, 60 km low voltage distribution lines, connection to 2800 houses. Total estimated cost - Rs. 125 million

9.3 Water supply

Tsunami has damaged the VVT water supply scheme and most of the wells along the coast. About 20 bowsers are temporarily supplying the drinking water.

The main source of drinking water in the peninsula is ground water. In the ground, fresh water lens is floating on sea water and the interface has got damaged due to Tsunami along the coast. Hence most of the wells have turned saline. Flushing out of the saline water has to undertaken through technicaly feasible methods.

Point Pedro and VVT Urban Council areas need water supply projects immediately. JBIC has agreed to fund the above projects – Coasting Rs. 350.0 million

9.4 Sanitation

Tsunami has damaged most of the latrines along the coast and polluted the ground water. Further more, VVT urban area is very congested and the wells are closer to the latrines. A proper sewerage system has to be designed and implemented immediately.

There is a serious fault in the latrines system of the district. The septic tank and the soakage pits are together and not separate compartments. Hence these are polluting the ground water.

Even the international agencies have not remedied this defect in their projects. We are appealing to the donors to insist on the implementing agencies to change the present designs.

9.5 Postal Department

Five sub post offices have been damaged.

9.6 Public Buildings under local authority

About 53 buildings have been damaged and the estimated cost is Rs. 148 million

9.7 Religious and cultural buildings

The estimated damage is given below;
