- * WITHDRAWAL OF TROOPS FROM THE TRADITIONAL TAMIL HOMELANDS
- * THE FREEDOM OF ALL POLITICAL PARTIES AND INDIVIDUALS TO CAMPAIGN FOR THEIR POLITICAL VIEWS WITHOUT PERSECUTION
- * THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INTERNATIONAL INDEPENDENT INQUIRY INTO THE VIOLENCE AGAINST TAMILS AND HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS IN SRI LANKA
